Winery: Bodegas Filón

D.O.: Calatayud

Wine Type: Red wine

Variety: 100% Garnacha Old Vines

Alcohol: 14.5 %

The winery is located in Villarroya de la Sierra, one of the highest areas of the DO made of Paleolithic materials, mainly quartzite and slate. In addition the soils have the right organic content, which provide sufficient nutrients to the plant with proper aeration. The climate offers little rain and large temperature fluctuations between day and night.

The grapes for Filón come from old vines vineyards, 30-40 years-old, with yields of 2T/Ha and located on the hillsides, 3,000 ft above sea level, around the north zone of Calatayud appellation.

Stainless steel fermented.

‘Bright ruby-red. Sexy scents of red fruit preserves, rose and spicecake are complemented by hints of licorice and white pepper. Conveys good energy and focus on the palate, offering gently sweet raspberry and bitter cherry flavors and a touch of spiciness. Closes juicy and persistent, with gentle tannins adding grip.

This wine spent three months in used French oak *barrisques* prior to bottling.”
