

Leyda Valley Las Terrazas Vineyard

This wine is from the Single Block N°22, at Las Terrazas Vineyard in Leyda Valley. This vineyard is located just 5 kilometres from the Pacific Ocean, north-south oriented, on a south-facing slope of 20°.

97 hectares of drip-irrigated vines with water from the Maipo River.

Production averages 6,000 kg/Ha.

The vines are trained along a VSP system.

Deep ruby with violet hues.

The nose initially reveals black and red berries, such as murtillas, blueberries, black plums and raspberries.

The mouth provides juicy black fruit flavours and balanced acidity, together with soft, well-rounded tannins over soft French oak.

Best served at between 14°C and 15°C.

This wine is excellent with oily fish, pasta, soup and cheese.
