

# Colchagua Valley Suspiro Vineyard

The planted area measures 749 hectares, which are drip-irrigated with water from deep wells. The average expected production is 12 tonnes per hectare. The vines are trained along a VSP system.

A deep cherry red wine with maroon hues. The bouquet is intense and attractive with upfront fresh black and red fruit aromas, such as blueberries, blackberries, blackcurrants, strawberries and cherries, as well as spicy and earthy notes that blend harmoniously with hints of chocolate and vanilla. This wine is notable for its delicious structure, well-balanced body and big, velvety tannins with great volume. An elegant, clean finish. Best served at between 16°C and 18°C, this wine is ideal with soft cheese, cream-based dishes, pasta and meat such as pork and lamb.
